
SCHOOL PANTRY (School Canteen)

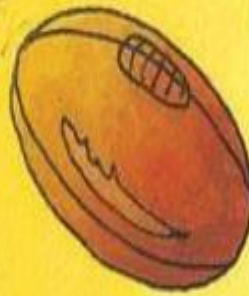
Games are played on Saturday mornings.

Footy Pie Day!



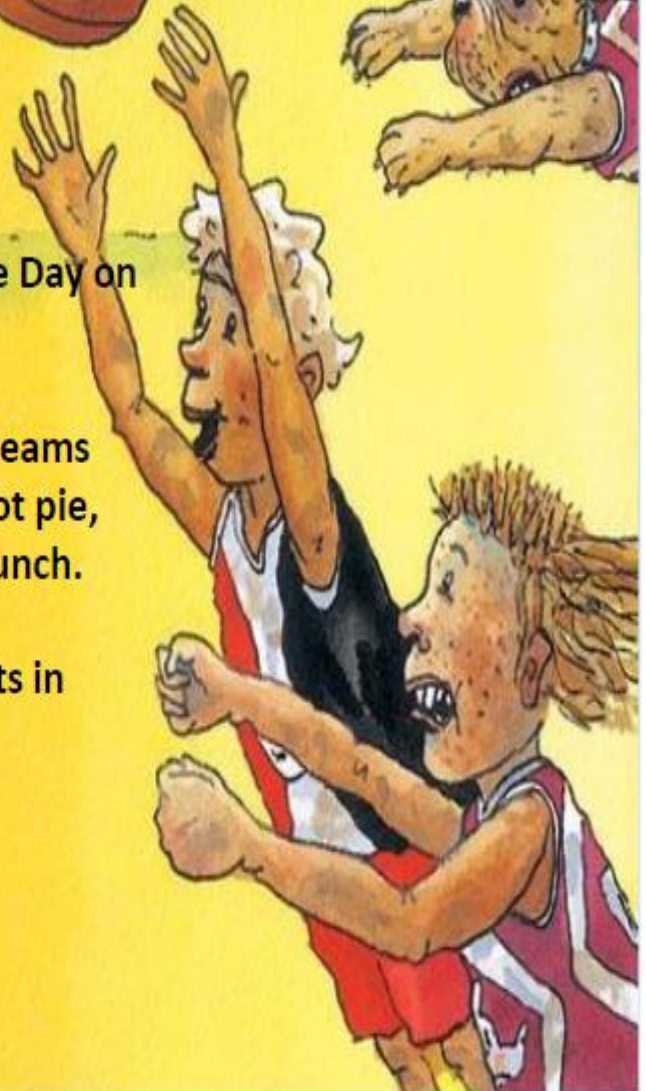
PWPS are having a Footy/Sports Pie Day on Thursday 21st September.
